Sending your SAT Scores to Colleges and Universities

You may send four free score reports, to colleges and universities, with your participation in the Michigan SAT School Day. If you haven't already done so, take advantage of these four score reports by May 16, 2016. After May 16, 2016, you may still send scores but there will be a fee of \$11.25 for each score report.

A: To send scores to colleges, you must have a College Board student account.

If you don't already have one, follow these easy steps to create a College Board Account.

1. Go to collegeboard.org.
2. Click on "Sign Up."
3. Select "I am a student."
4. Complete the student account form to create a username and password.
 - Your username should have 6–15 characters and be made up of letters and numbers.
 - Your password must be 7–15 characters with at least one number and one letter.
 - Choose a security question and provide an answer you can easily remember.
5. Click the box at the bottom of the page to agree to the Terms & Conditions and select "Next."
6. Check the boxes to verify your information is correct and select "Confirm."

B: Link your April 2016 Michigan SAT School Day registration to your account.

1. Go to collegeboard.org.
2. Enter your username and password. If you are already logged in and do not see the username/password option, continue to step #3



Score Sends

- ▶ Students may send score reports at any time from their College Board account.
- ▶ Michigan students have until May 16, 2016, to take advantage of their four free score reports by entering the schools to which they wish to send scores. After May 16, there will be a fee.
- ▶ Michigan students taking the SAT on a Saturday national administration date students will have up to 9 days after the test to send scores.
- ▶ Student who are eligible for SAT fee waivers will receive an additional four free score reports.
- ▶ Once scores are available, they will be automatically sent to the schools identified.



The DAT is an administrative role and does not automatically get rights to reports. If you are the DAT, you need to assign yourself access to the reports.

AP Potential

- ▶ AP Potential is available for students in their portal
 - ▶ Students taking PSAT 8/9 will only see AP Potential for AP World History and AP European History
- ▶ Educators have access through their College Board account
- ▶ AP Potential = 60% chance of getting a 3+ on an AP exam
 - ▶ Within the tool, you can modify this percentage based on your school's needs
