Learn to notice-When you judge children you tell them who they should be. Judgment is conditional. Encouragement is about accepting children for who they are.

Praise Judges:

"Good Job Erica."

"That was excellent."

"That was a great slide."

Noticing (Describes) *Encouragement*

"Erica you put your toys in the bin."

"You did it. You finished all of your homework."

"You did it. You came down the slide feet first."
