AFTER YOU HAVE RECEIVED THE QUIZ OR TEST TO TAKE HOME FOR PARENT SIGNATURE:

- A.** USE LOOSE-LEAF TO ANSWER THE QUESTIONS. STAPLE PAGES IF YOU USE MORE THAN 1 PAGE.
- B.** PRINT YOUR NAME, DATE AND HOUR ON EACH PAGE YOU USE. 
- C.** YOU SHOULD WRITE IN COMPLETE SENTENCES. You may make a list for **#5.** & **#6.**
- D.** PLEASE SKIP A LINE AFTER EACH PARAGRAPH.
- E.** DO NOT RETURN YOUR QUIZ OR TEST. DO NOT TURN IN YOUR CORRECTIONS.
