Board Policy 5611, Due Process, calls for the Board to appoint a Reinstatement Review Panel composed of two Board members, one administrator, one teacher, and one parent to review a petition for reinstatement of a student following expulsion when such a petition is received during the school year. Hence, the appointment of a standing panel is a prudent provision to make as part of the Board of Education's organizational items. However, the approval of all members of the Reinstatement Review Panel did not occur at the organizational meeting in January, 2012.

The Board was asked to approve a Reinstatement Review Panel to serve from August through December, 2012 to handle any requests for reinstatement that are presented. A panel and alternates have been identified with the assistance of the PTO Council and GPEA.
