# V. <u>DISCUSSION</u>

# A. Technology Overview

Superintendent Harwood provided a vision for the district's technology plan for "today, tomorrow and beyond". He highlighted the district's current use of technology and future trends and needs in the development of a sound and effective technological infrastructure. Dr. Harwood shared key traits of the student learner profile and 21<sup>st</sup> Century Learner; the mission, vision and goals for technology; and learning in a digital age.

Dr. Harwood concluded his presentation with the proposed next steps the district would need to take to begin to transform and empower student learning through technology. He also proposed the possibility of a Technology Bond and what would need to be considered to bring that proposal forward on the ballot for the November, 2013 election date.

## **B.** Discipline Data Update

Superintendent Harwood provided information on student discipline based on the number of students and the number of incidents recorded throughout the year to date. Board member questions included:

- How many of the students being disciplined are escalating in behaviors leading to more severe discipline?
- Are there ways to solve the problem behaviors without escalating the discipline measures?
- Are special needs students being over-disciplined?

Dr. Dean answered Board questions noting that some of the students being disciplined were only a one-time offense and their problematic behaviors had not escalated to continued or more severe discipline measures. He also said that staff are always seeking alternative ways to work with problem behaviors.

## C. Review of Proposed District Goals
