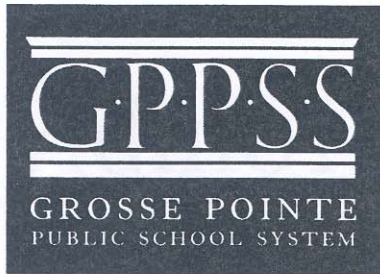


Dear Parents,

In a previous correspondence, we mentioned that the school district would be installing a buzzer entry system at Trombly. During the past two weeks the alarm company has been busy at work installing the new system. Today the final pieces were added and the system is now ready to be used.

Starting Monday, November 3 the new buzzer entry system will be operational. What that means to any visitor to Trombly is they no longer will be able to gain access to the building without ringing the bell. All building doors will be locked at 8:30 AM. Anyone wanting to gain entry into the building after 8:30 AM will now have to ring the buzzer either at the receiving door or the main Beaconsfield door. You will be asked to identify yourself and state the purpose of your visit. You then will be let into the building.

We ask that you be patient and understanding as we roll out this system. This is also new part of our daily routine.
