Both classes enjoyed decorating pumpkins for the Barnes Annual Pumpkin Contest! After decorating, the children had the opportunity to vote on their favorite pumpkin. The winner of the Barnes School Contest was the Ice Cream Sundae Pumpkin by the Toddler 2 Class! Both Classes are getting practice walking up and down the stairs as we are using the Cozy Corner, otherwise know as the "Upstairs Sensory Motor Room." We are learning tht we have a left and a right hand. When we walk upstairs, we hold the railing with our left hand and when we walk downstairs we use our right hand.
