## A Day in ECP

Activity	Description/Instructional Focus *Developmental Domain Area
Quiet Table Play	Play quietly at table seat with toy of choice*LANGUAGE/AFFECTIVE (Social/Emotional)-Use time for each child to tell about his/her preferred toy
Snack	Choose a snack item, safe eating, polite language, conversation, follow directions *FINE MOTOR/SOCIAL/LANGUAGE
Snack Table Play	Work with manipulatives, follow directions, safety, small sand box play, sharing and taking turns *MOTOR SKILLS/LANGUAGE/SOCIAL
Show and Tell	Featured item from the Star of the day, ask questions *LANGUAGE/SOCIAL/COGNITIVE
Magic Coloring	Flip paper over and color picture; Coloring Skills, holding paper with helping hand, color with working hand, learning coloring strokes, starting with wiggles, up/down, side/side *LANGUAGE/FINE MOTOR
Dismissal	Learning the dismissal procedure, waiting turn, following directions *LANGUAGE/SOCIAL

## Curricular Components Class Strategies (SR3)

6.

- Structure: Provide supports to promote success
- Routine: Provide consistent routine so children know what will happen next
- Repetition: Provide multiple opportunities and contexts to learn skills
- Responding: Provide multiple opportunities to respond; promote verbal responses, daily chants for activities and transitions
- All strategies are designed to enhance overall Speech, Language, and Communication skills!







# Curricular Components Thematic Content

- Learning in Preschool is done through providing many opportunities for hands on learning.
- Build thematic content around children's interests using Literature Favorites, such as <u>Brown Bear</u>, <u>Brown</u> <u>Bear</u> by Bill Martin Jr. and other great books!
- Featured themes will always be listed in the Weekly Newsletters
- Teach colors, shapes, numbers, letters, etc.
