Readers Read Emergent Story Books

Students learn:

- Readers read books in many different ways.
- Readers use pictures to help them read familiar books.
- Readers use pictures to help them read unknown books.
- Readers read books in order.
- Readers read books using character voices.
- Readers read books by looking at character's expression and text.
- Readers stay focused on reading.
- Readers keep their eyes on the pages of the book they are reading.
- Readers think about books as they read.
- Readers re-read books.
- Readers re-read books from the previous day.
- Readers notice new details each time they read.
- Readers read with partners and listen carefully.
- Readers read next to and take turns with partners.
- Reading partners both keep their eyes on the books.
- Reading partners help each other with tricky parts.
- Readers share their favorite part of a book with a partner.
- Readers share something they notice with a partner.
