Concept 1: Readers relate characters to themselves and other characters.

Concept 2:

Readers think and talk about characters to deepen comprehension.

- Readers flag pages to help them hold thinking about their characters.

- Readers think about how their characters are feeling.
- Readers reflect on their character's change and development over time.
- Readers include parts of text in their talk about the characters they talk about.
