- 2. Review of the Previous Minutes Erin Weakland
  - a. Correction to LaKeytria's name. Correct time for Skate Night.
  - b. Lindy makes a motion to pass Oct meeting minutes, Kelly seconds motion passed.
- 3. Treasurer's Report Stephen Justin
  - a. Current available \$33k, reserve funds for green house (\$5k) and start up (\$4k).
  - b. Budget planned in August, balanced budget \$53k. Approved in October, additional \$19k in expenses
    - i. Literacy fund
    - ii. Hospitality
    - iii. Teacher led clubs
    - iv. Subscription for S'more
  - c. Income YTD \$19k with another \$38k from Fun Run
  - d. Expenses YTD \$28k spend with \$43k outstanding
    - i. Expenses for teacher enrichment
    - ii. Dragon Fun Run
    - iii. Cider and Donuts
    - iv. Literacy Fund
    - v. Staff conferences
    - vi. Literacy kits
  - e. Fun Run
    - i. Note the Get Moving Crew charges a service fee of 15%
    - ii. \$58k earned, \$48k realized due to fees
      - 1. \$450 set up fee and 15% of funds received online.
      - 2. People that donate online, are given an option to cover the 15% fee when they donate. But not all donors choose this option.
      - 3. This service has been reviewed, compared with other providers and Get Moving was used because its so user friendly. The Fun Run requires an enormous amount of work to manage and run.

## **Budget Discussion**

Prior to this meeting, the PTO Board met to discuss current budget. Keeping needs/requests in mind, while we continue to be good stewards of the PTO funds. We must remain fiscally responsible.

- b. We are hoping to keep our reserve higher than the \$9k to get us through the first few months of the next school year
- c. We have allocated \$43k that has already been approve
  - i. We can also look to cut things that have already been approved to free up funds.
- d. After this, we will have about \$5k available to spend
- e. This year, spending the money towards library tables feels like a stretch. Unless we want to cut other budget items.
- f. Budgeted for \$53k, currently showing total expenses at \$72k
  - i. Increased hospitality
  - ii. S'more
  - iii. Recess Equipment
  - iv. Literacy Funds
  - v. Teacher Clubs
- g. Other items that have been requested: Teacher lounges, playground equipment, etc.
- h. Jane Nugent suggests creating a top 10 lists / survey in the spring on items to fund for the next school year.
- i. We will circle back on this issue

- a. JJ will work on publishing posts that highlight all the events/items funded by the Fun Run.
- b. Reminder that all our events are free of charge to all, because they are sponsored by the Fun Run
