1. Call to Order and Introductions: Dani Raether

Defer PTO Mission Statement read.

Dani R. related that this is a transitional year as the School Board has voted to close Trombley and shift all students to Defer. As this decision is not finalized, we will wait to make plans regarding a shift to a larger school population.

2. Review of the May Minutes: Marianne Grano

May minutes were not sent via email, so May and August will be revised and approved for September meeting.

3. Treasurer's Report: Amy Leech

Budget Review for 2019 – 2020. Suggested changes:

- Increase projected Fun Run income to \$25.5k (2018 actual \$28.7k)
- Decrease Defer Wear to net \$50 (2018 actual \$50)
- Increase projected Box Top income to \$420 (2018 actual \$541)
- Increase Book Fair income and expense to \$5.5k each
- Increase Holiday Craft Fair income and expense to \$2.2k each
- New or increased expenses:
 - School technology hardware--\$5k
 - o School technology subscriptions—\$3.5k
 - o Classroom seating--\$3.5k
 - o Classroom books--\$3k
 - o One Book One School books--\$400
 - Leader In Me Parent Resources \$150
 - School print subscriptions--\$3.5k
 - o 4th grade promotion added--\$400
 - o Movie Night--\$850
 - o Grounds upkeep--\$600
 - o Dani G. suggested addition of line item for 4th grade trip.
- Suggested expense reductions:
 - Homework Club lowered to \$500 based on past expense
 - o Lunchtime Enrichment lowered to \$400 based on past expense
 - Field Day—suggested elimination based on 2 years no expenses.
 - o Progressive Dinner—budgeting \$700 for Park Grille.

o Misc--\$350 (down from \$500)

Revised budget attached. Total projected net income: (\$7630). Note that this projected loss is similar to last year's budget, and last year's actual income was \$9,908.41.

Dani G. moves approval of the budget. Chelsea C. seconded. Motion carried.

5. Committee Reports:

Volunteers – Kristine Hayes –transitioned with former chair. Need 4th grade promotion chair; Lindy H. would like to co-chair. Kristine to get in touch with Sara M. for communications.

- a. Fundraising Chelsea Crosby & Beth Lowe. Frisbees are in production for Fun Run. Looking into prizes of spirit wear. Lots of updates on Get Movin' Crew website; prize can be featured when kids sign up; will need long code for kids to sign up (there is now more than one Defer Elementary using the service). There's a donor map and a teacher portal. Employer match is easier. We are adding over \$400 per family prize. Martin Photography, TCBY, Cornwall, Pepsi, GPP Parks and Recreation, and Buscemi's are among committed sponsors.
- b. Membership Brooke Macuga –has ordered T-shirts but they are not in yet; updating picnic flyer and directory.
- c. Hospitality Christy Sherding –transitioning with Holly. Has to finalize number of popsicles. She will get cake for picnic. Cornwall Bakery is our morning destination for first day of school.
- d. Communications Sara Martin. Sara is creating a "chair tip sheet" for people chairing committees about communication procedures, reimbursement, existing stock, and budgeting; include tax exempt forms. Dani has created spreadsheet for special event calendar.
- e. School Board Observer Lisa Dougherty –At June meeting, Poupard and Trombley closed and 4th grade moving to middle school. Proposal is that 100% of Trombley will move to Defer and Maire and Richard boundaries will not change. Magnet would move to another school and multi-age move to Maire. Reminder to be sensitive and thoughtful in social media posting.
- f. Technology Coordinator Megan Bejin –Need to communicate with faculty to get subscriptions paid for by PTO.

- 7. **Principal's Report:** Lisa Rheaume –New staff joining us; new office clerk; new day custodian; new school psychologist; new librarian.
