 - b. Wish list items We have extra funds so we will probably be able to purchase extra items off the wish list. The following items were top priority for this year's budget:
 - i. \$200/classroom for flexible seating (\$3200) 1 order. Approved.
 - ii. Water Cooler for teacher's lounge (\$500/year) Approved.
 - iii. 1 set of ipads for 7 classrooms (\$4640 up to \$5000) Approved.
 - iv. 4 /5 Magnet 15 Chrome Books + charging cart (\$4500) Approved.
 - c. Teacher Enrichment for 2018/19 to be given in August as gift cards: \$200/full time teacher.
