FUN RUN UPDATE:

- Approx. \$30, 350.00 Gross (\$7000+ more than last year)
- 94% of students registered sunglasses may have contributed
- 35 Super Stars raised over \$250.00
- Online Total: \$23,135 (84% of online donors added the 9% charge to their donation)
- In School Total: \$7100.00
- Today we did a popsicle donation for the whole school to celebrate our success
- All schools received pizza party, fun days, popsicle, and fun run
- All prizes were donated
- 205 students have surpassed \$50 they will receive Sweeties gift card
- Total Expenses: approx. \$1500.00
