- 1 Old T-shirt (adult size) for going to art class. Write your child's name in HUGE letters on the front of the shirt. This is also to be kept in your child's locker and will be worn for art class.
- 6 large Extreme glue sticks .77oz (22g). Please do not send in glue pens, paste or gel. Do not label.
- 1 box of Crayola washable color markers (thick children's size). (10 colors) Do not label.
- 3 boxes Crayola MINI primary color Twistables crayons. (24 colors) Do not label.
- 4 boxes of Kleenex. Do not label.
- 4 rolls paper towels. Do not label.
- 1 FAMILY photograph to go in our class photo album. Please write your child's name on the back.
