Isolate student exhibiting symptoms in designated area (follow isolation guidelines). Contact parent for student pick-up. Send staff exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19 home immediately. Strongly recommend contacting a medical provider and <u>COVID-19 viral testing</u>.

1. School to complete COVID-19 student or staff report form and email to CD-k12schools@waynecounty.com

2. Keep staff/student in home isolation for a minimum 10 days with fever resolved for at least 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication before returning to school. Staff/Student may return to school with proof of negative result, provided symptoms have improved and fever resolved for at least 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication.
