Summer Pointes - Lit Labs

The Lit Lab is an innovative, grant funded 6-week summer learning program focused on engaging students in early literacy, writing, math, and STEM-based lab challenges. This invitation-only program is available to rising Kindergarten-4th Grade students that fit select academic criteria and will be run at Richard Elementary School.

- Monday-Thursday from 8:30am-12:30pm
- June 24-27 and July 8-August 8 (No Summer Pointes week of July 1-5)
- Attendance is mandatory for the duration of the 6 week program

Summer Pointes - Boys College

The Boys College Summer Literacy Institute (BCSLI) is a grant-funded advanced literacy learning model. Based on the research of Dr. Alfred Tatum, students engage in a Multidimensional Reading Model that focuses on reading and writing across the academic disciplines. This invitation-only program is available to 4th & 5th grade African American boys that fit selected academic criteria and will be run at Richard Elementary School.

- Monday-Thursday from 8:30am-12:30pm
- June 24-27 and July 8-August 8 (No Summer Pointes week of July 1-5)
- Attendance is mandatory for the duration of the 6 week program

Summer Pointes - Secondary

Incoming grades 5-9: Information regarding the Summer Pointes Secondary program will be communicated through building principals and school counselors. This invitation-only program will be broken down into two-week standalone sessions and run at Parcels Middle School.

- Monday - Thursday 8:15-11:15 am
- Session 1: June 24-27, July 8-11
- Session 2: July 15-25
- Session 3: July 29-Aug 8

Incoming grades 10-12: Credit recovery information will be communicated through school counselors. This program is open to all rising 10th-12th grade students, and coursework must be completed by August 15. In-person academic support from Grosse Pointe teachers will be offered at Parcels Middle School from 8:15-11:15 am Monday - Thursday, June 17 - August 15. **Note that there will be no in-person support offered on June 19th or the week of July 1st.**

Registration:

A list of eligible K-9 students will be provided to building principals after break. Building principals will provide more information to grant eligible students as it becomes available. Specific details about registration will be provided to families after spring break.

Tentative Registration and timeline:

- **Cohort selection group 1:**
 - **Registration sign-up - April 8th-April 12th**
 - Students who are below the 30th percentile on NWEA Reading, qualify for reading support, receive concern area (CA) in ELA on report card.
- **Cohort Selection Group 2:**
 - **If space is still available registration sign-up April 22nd-26th**
 - Students who are below the 40th percentile on NWEA Reading.
