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2023 SUMMER POINTES PROGRAM

GPPSS is fortunate to have grant money to support the learning needs of our students this summer. Summer Pointes is a free, invitation-only program focused on addressing learning loss to bring students up to grade level.

Program Focus:

- Targeted intervention focusing on learning loss in the area of literacy and numeracy
- A small instructor-to-student ratio, pending staffing and enrollment
- A focus on learning rather than summative assessments, grades, etc.

Eligibility:

Eligibility for Summer Pointes is based on academic needs in literacy and numeracy. Selection into the program will be based on a tiered approach:

- **Cohort selection group 1:**
 - **Registration sign-up April 10th-April 14th**
 - Students who are below the 30th percentile on NWEA Math or Reading, qualify for reading support, receive concern area (CA) in ELA or Math on report card.
- **Cohort Selection Group 2:**
 - **If space is still available registration sign-up April 24th-28th**
 - Students who are below the 40th percentile on NWEA Math or Reading.

Sessions:

Three two-week standalone K-8 sessions will run Monday-Thursday.

- Session 1: June 19-29
- Session 2: July 10-20
- Session 3: July 24- August 3

Locations/Time:

- Grades K-4 – Richard Elementary / 8:30 a.m.-11:30 a.m.
- Grades 5-8 – Parcels Middle School / 8:15 a.m.-11:15 a.m.

Registration:

Eligible students will be notified by their classroom teacher or middle school counselor. If you have questions about eligibility, please contact your child's teacher or counselor.
