You need:


9" x 12" construction paper Postcard template Crayons or colored pencils Glue Pencil

Directions:

- 1. Read a good realistic fiction chapter book
- 2. Using the postcard template, write a letter to the author on the left hand side telling what you liked about the book. Remember to use correct letter form. Be sure to sign your name at the end of your letter.
- 3. On the right hand side, address the postcard properly. Your name and address should be on the lines under "from". Write the author's name and make up an address for the author on the lines

under "to". Design and color a stamp in the corner.

- 4. Glue your postcard template to a 9×12 sheet of white construction paper. Draw and color your idea for a cover of the book. Use the whole side of this paper. Include the title of the book and the author.
- 4. Bring your postcard to school by the date above. Be prepared to share it with the class.
