Parent Remote Learning Expectations

Students and parents can expect the following five components during times of remote learning. This applies to Grosse Pointe Virtual and Face2Face for all stakeholders, students, teachers, and parents.

- Consistent daily learning schedule
- Multiple weekly opportunities for synchronous and asynchronous instruction
- Multiple weekly opportunities for learning support
- Weekly communication of learning progress
- Consistent organization of course materials in Schoology

Support Norms (Parents):

- Consistent daily & weekly learning schedule:
 - Support students in following the outlined Learning Schedule for their grade level & course
 - Work to minimize distractions
- Multiple weekly opportunities for synchronous (live with teacher) and asynchronous instruction
 - Work to ensure that students attend all synchronous learning sessions and complete all asynchronous learning experiences
 - Support and help foster relationships and meaningful connections through consistent opportunities for instruction
 - Identify a specific place where the learning will take place in the home
 - Utilize district resources (Chromebook, Internet Access, etc.)
- Multiple weekly opportunities for learning support
 - Learning Labs will include three parts: teacher interacting with content (not new), student practice with content and a question and answer session
 - Support Sessions will include opportunities for students to drop-in as needed for clarification around an assignment and/or content to answer questions as needed
 - Encourage your student to attend and actively participate during Learning Labs and utilize live Support Sessions with teacher support
- Weekly communication of learning progress
 - Turn on Schoology "Notifications"
 - Review weekly agenda for each course
 - Review Gradebook "Notes" for specific feedback on individual assignments
 - Reach out to teachers directly with questions through Schoology
- Consistent organization of course materials in Schoology (Learning Management System)
 - Courses will include visual tools for easy navigation
 - Course materials will be organized in folders by week, unit or module

Parent Learning Sessions:

Asynchronous mini lessons will help parents navigate courses, understand the gradebook, set up their notifications, clarify whom to contact for specific challenges, and tips and tricks to help their students find success during Remote Learning. All parents are to take advantage of these learning opportunities.

Asynchronous: Learning experiences created by the teacher which are accessible at any time.

Synchronous: Real time learning with the teacher.
