# Richard Drop Off + Pick Up Guidelines

We need to work together to keep the drop off/pick up line moving and all our kids safe! Please remember, unless you are a kindergarten or Y5 parent, please do not leave your car. It is also important that you drop off and pick up using your driver's side door and PLEASE do not have your child cut between cars to get to you! The guidelines below may be modified prior to the 2022-2023, any updates will be shared.



### Walkers:

- Students will line up at assigned doors
- Y5 and K use McKinley Doors
- 1st and 2nd grade use Playground Doors
- 3rd, 4th, and Magnet use doors by kindergarten classrooms off the parking lot
- Staff will meet you at the doors to let students in

### **Bus:**

- Students who ride the bus will be dropped off at the receiving room doors.
- Your teacher will meet you there.

### **Parent Drop Off:**

- Line up at assigned doors
  - o Y5 and K use McKinley Doors
  - 1st and 2nd grade use Playground Doors
  - o 3rd, 4th, and Magnet use doors by kindergarten classrooms off the parking lot
  - ASD classrooms use receiving room doors

## **Departure:**

- Students will be let out the doors they arrived through
- Young Fives and Kindergarten will be dismissed to their individual parent/guardian at 3:30
- 1st-4th will be let out under staff supervision and are expected to go to their parent/guardian or begin walking home at 3:38 pm

### Remember:

With space being limited around Richard, it is important that we remember a few things.

- When entering our parking lot, please be sure to drive around the circle and not turn left at the first opening. Our parking lot is one way!
- Use the back parking lot circle to drop off your older students. Simply pull in and use your passenger side door to let them out.
- When in our lot, please only use the passenger side doors to let your students out.
- There is no parking on McKinley once you get to the school grounds. Please drop your child off and leave so the next parent can pull up. Make sure you get your extra hugs and high fives before drop-off!
- On McKinley, only drop your child off using the driver's side door. This eliminates stepping into traffic.
- Be sure to not park in the circle or on McMillan so buses can get through.
- If you would like to watch your student enter the building, you can park further down McKinley, some places on Ridge, spaces on Kercheval, or down a side street and walk your child to school.
- Half-Day Preschool drop off drivers, please wait until your teacher comes out to send your child to the
  doors
- Full-Day preschool can park in the back circle to bring their child to the office if they arrive after 8:35 AM.
