

If you don't want to use wifi you can plug an Ethernet cable directly into the side of your laptop.



The Ethernet port is on the right side of the case if you are facing the screen.



To connect the Ethernet cord, first expand the Ethernet port on the laptop with your fingers.

The bottom part of it is on a hinge and you need to pull it down about ¼ inch.

You will see a green and orange link lights on the laptop where you plugged it in.

When connected you will see the Ethernet icon on bottom right of the screen.

Stuck hinge. If you need to remove the Ethernet make sure to keep the hinge pulled down.

Pull down hinge.

Keeping your find on the hinge, remove cord.
