# **Remote Learning Resources**

• **Khan Academy** - (K-12, College) among the best free online resources for students, especially for learning math and science. For preschoolers (age 2+), download the free app **Khan Academy Kids**.

- <u>Unite for Literacy</u> books are written in English or Spanish, but have narration available in multiple languages, including Arabic, Spanish, Hindi, Hmong, and Armenian.
- World Book online content rich videos and reading with ability to translate text and read-aloud while
  highlighting the text in multiple languages, for World Book Early Learning, World Book Kids and World
  Book Student.
- <u>PBS Kids</u> games and activities for kids to play and learn at home. Parents can also sign up for the <u>New Daily Newsletter</u> for update activities.
- **Hooda Math** math games by grade and by subjects, K-12.
- **Prodigy** math games, K-8. Families can sign in with a google account or sign up for a free account.
