A. Escuchar – During the exam, you will listen to two people talking about their classes. They will mention a class they like and why and then a class they don't like and why not. You will be explaining in English what they said. Feel free to brainstorm some phrases or words you might hear like the words for "I like" and "I don't like."

B. Escribir – You will be expected to fill in the correct subject pronouns (yo, tú, él, etc.). There are twelve. See página 96 in your textbook to check your work. Remember that we usually group these by conjugation form so this chart is just a little different.

C. Escoger – Multiple choice – You will be expected to choose the best option that completes a phrase or answers a question. You're a pro at this already. ☺

D. Escribir – You will be expected to respond to two prompts.

One prompt will ask you about a class, so you have to say what class it is, what hour you have it, an adjective to describe the class, and who teaches it. Yep- ALL that information. ¡Puedes hacerlo! You can do it!

Use the area below to brainstorm or draft a possible response.
For example, respond to the question and give the listed information:
¿Qué clase tienes en la segunda hora?

The second writing prompt will ask you to describe an image, saying where things are in complete sentences. Use the image below to draft a response and practice your sentences with prepositions (encima de, delante de, debajo de, etc...). A good practice activity would be to label as many things as possible and write ten sentences about where things are in the *sala de clases*. Notice that the teacher seems to be eating a *taco y un perrito caliente* with *una bebida gaseosa* (soda).
