You can even add clipart next to them 😊</p>	<p>FREE CHOICE</p> <p>Think of a creative activity to do with your <u>10 pattern words</u>.</p>	<p>Spelling Math</p> <p>Figure out how much each of your <u>5 high frequency words</u> is worth. A=1, B=2...Z=26 Write the word next to the value.</p>
<p>Write a Song</p> <p>Write a song or rap that includes your <u>5 high frequency words</u>. Share with a friend or family member. You may share it with the class only if you choose to.</p>	<p>Tasty Word Work</p> <p>With a parent's permission, spray a small amount of whipped cream and spread it out on a countertop. Write your <u>10 pattern words</u> in the whipped cream with your finger. Spell them out loud as you write them. Parent Signature required!</p> <hr/>	<p>Making Words</p> <p>Write your <u>10 pattern words</u>. Next to each word, write at least two other words that can be spelled using the letters in your word. Example: pickle= lick, like, lip...</p>
