Would you like to improve your grade?

If you would like to improve your grade you may complete test corrections.

For each corrected answer you will receive half the points back. This adds up quickly, it is worth your time!
There are 2 parts, make sure you complete both parts!

PART I:

ON A SEPARATE SHEET OF PAPER...

- 1) Write down the incorrect **QUESTION AND THE ANSWER YOU CHOOSE**.
- 2) Write down the **CORRECT ANSWER WITH AN EXPLANATION STATING WHY THAT ANSWER IS CORRECT**.
- 3) Write down *why* you got that answer wrong.
 - Some reasons why you may have gotten it wrong are...
 - Read the question too quickly
 - Did not understand a word in the question
 - Did not study that material
 - Got the question confused with another question
 - Silly mistake, should have proofread my work.

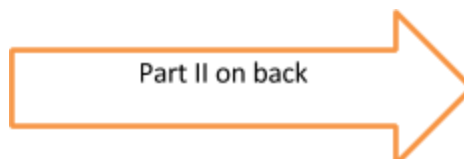
Example:

#2: This picture shows that one of the main motivations of the Spanish exploring North America was to promote...

My answer: a) slavery

Correct answer: c) religion

Explanation: This picture shows that religion was one of the main motivating forces because there is a person praying and they have a cross hanging around their neck. I also know that the three main reasons for European exploration were God, Gold, and Glory. Religion and God are in the same category. I got this answer wrong because I did not look at the picture closely. I rushed through the test.
