THE COACHES-

Diane Montgomery- Head Coach

Diane Montgomery is a native of Walled Lake, Michigan, and has a strong background that includes numerous high school and road racing victories. Coach Montgomery or "Monty" has been with the boys cross country program since 2007 and has been coaching the girls track team since 2004. This will be Montgomery's 14th year as head coach.

Coach Monty has a strong coaching resume and was a head boys and girls cross country coach in Georgia before coming back to Michigan and Grosse Pointe North. She is also head coach of girls track, 2018-2019 Region Team Champions.

Montgomery is also an avid road racer and participated in the Boston Marathon in April 2010. Of special note, Coach Monty has run a marathon in all fifty states. Montgomery has completed 73 marathons and two 50 mile races. Coach Montgomery taught English at North for 20 years and retired in 2021.

Joe Ciaravino- Asst. Coach

JoeCiaravino (Coach C) joined the coaching staff in 2010 and made an immediate impact with his expertise and enthusiasm. As a Grosse Pointe North student and runner, Joe was a member of the 1973, 75, and 76 State Champ teams!

Coach Ciaravino is also a math teacher at Parcells Middle School. This key placement means that Coach C is in charge of recruitment for incoming freshmen from Parcells.

Coach Ciaravino also coaches the boys distance runners during track season. In 2018, he coached an outstanding 5 runners to a sub 4:40 time in the 1600 meters (1 mile) and 3 runners to a sub 9:50 time in the 3200 meters (2 mile). In 2019, he has coached 3 runners to a sub 4:30 in the mile and 1 runner to a sub 9:30 in the 2 mile.

What's great about GPNXC? We celebrate all progress! From the #1 runner to the last runner, personal improvement is celebrated and rewarded! You will get a lot out of this program! Our program continues to be one of the most successful sports teams at Grosse Pointe North. We routinely finish in the top of the MAC Red Conference. In 2017, we were MAC Red Champs and runner-up in the entire Macomb Area Conference. In 2018, we were MAC and Region champs. Many of our athletes go on to a collegiate running career.






