Love them or hate them, ebooks are here to stay, and young readers especially tend to appreciate their "cool" factor! All of these sources offer free and easy access to an assortment of ebooks for downloading or reading on your device of choice.



HOOPLA offers lots of ebooks as well as audiobooks, movies, television shows, music albums, and comics, all available 24/7 with no waiting ever. Sign up with your GP Public Library card to borrow up to 10 items each month. Service features a kid-friendly filter; a free app is available for mobile devices.

SORA/OVERDRIVE has over 400 popular ebooks and audiobooks for kids, hand-picked by GPPS library teachers. Browse, or search by subject or title. Search "currently available" if you don't want to wait--unlike HOOPLA, a SORA title is unavailable while someone else is enjoying it. Students can create an account using their school ID and password.



EXPLORA is a database offering informational ebooks as well as encyclopedia, magazine, and newspaper articles about a wide variety of topics of interest to young readers. Stream full text or download.



EBSCO Browse almost 4000 children's and young adult fiction and non-fiction titles. Sort by genre or subject. Read summaries to help find that just-right book!



BookFLIX pairs informational ebooks with story book videos on related themes. Learn about monkeys and then watch "Curious George"! Ebooks, several available in Spanish, include interactive glossaries and can be set to read aloud. Access BookFLIX with a valid GP Public Library card number.
