First, I want to again thank you for your efforts to support our community and students during this unprecedented time. As I'm sure you are aware, earlier today <u>Governor Whitmer issued an executive</u> <u>order</u> that takes effect tomorrow morning. The order does a variety of important things, but one of the outcomes of this order is that the earliest we will be returning to regular face-to-face operation as a school district is Tuesday, April 14th. We will continue to monitor information from the State of Michigan and will adjust our school plans accordingly.

Virtual Board Meeting tonight

The meeting will not physically be occurring at Brownell. Food Services reduced for safety

We have decided to edit the meal serving times and locations in order to minimize exposure to our associates, the public, and the school buildings themselves. New serving times **this week**:

- Days: Wednesday and Friday
- Times: 10am-1pm
- Location: Poupard ONLY at 20655 Lennon in Harper Woods
- Food service is suspended at Defer as of today, due to low usage and staffing. This week we will continue service at Poupard on Wednesday 3/25 & Friday 3/27 from 10 a.m.-1 p.m. only.
- Starting next week food will be distributed from **Poupard on Tuesday 3/31 only 10 a.m.-1 p.m.** Chartwells will be prepared to distribute 7 days of food that Tuesday.
