Hand Washing and Respiratory Etiquette

Physical/Social Distancing		
Staff required to be at least 6 feet from another.	Students spaced 3-6 feet apart with desk shields. Restrooms are socially distanced and limited students allowed in elementary.	No Physical/Social Distancing required.

All Athletic Events are canceled.	Athletic events are allowed with additional health and safety protocols. Athletic testing will follow MHSSA and State requirements.	Athletic events are allowed.
Cleaning and Disinfecting		
All school building are disinfected and cleaned before student/staff Return.	Restrooms are cleaned every four hours. Classrooms are cleaned every night. <b>Food Service/Lunch</b>

<b>Visitors and Volunteers</b>

Gathering and Facilities Use		
No gathering or use of School Buildings/Playgrounds by Public. Staff may use Buildings for Remote Instruction.	Restrictions on Gathering Size and additional health and safety protocols may be implemented. Use of facilities by groups may be restricted.	Buildings/ Playgrounds available for Regular use per policy.
Extracurricular and Field Trips		
Field trips and Extracurricular Activities are canceled.	Field trips and Extracurricular are allowed with additional health and safety protocols.	Field trips and Extracurricular are allowed as normal.
Meeting/Office		
All Meeting are Remote and Offices are closed. Staff may use Buildings for Remote Instruction.	Meetings are allowed with allowed with additional health and safety protocols. Staff allowed back in Office with Masking requirements/Social Distancing are required. Hand Sanitizer provided to all staff.	In-Person meetings are allowed and Offices will be open for regular operation.
