Magnet FAQ

If we opt for OneGp Virtual will my child have a magnet teacher/magnet program experience or just a traditional 3rd or 4th grade experience.	OneGP Virtual is intended to provide a 100% virtual environment for students with course offerings focused on providing learning opportunities to advance in the GPPSS curriculum. These course offerings include instruction in all core areas as well as some electives. Specific programs and electives will only be offered in OneGP Virtual based on enrollment. If enough Magnet enrolled students elect OneGP Virtual to warrant a section of Magnet, the program will be offered. We do know that students that require a 'level up' for math can be fully accommodated in OneGP Virtual. There is no guarantee that a Magnet opportunity will be offered in OneGP Virtual. With that said, parents can still opt for OneGP Virtual and teachers will differentiate learning needs within a heterogeneous environment.
If we do OneGp Virtual and then return to in-person instruction in January, will my child return to magnet at the original school or any available 4th grade class in the district?	There is no guarantee of a magnet slot for the second semester. If there would be room, GPPSS would grant it.
If my child does return to magnet but had a non magnet teacher first semester how will he "catch up" with his magnet peers?	Teachers will continue to differentiate learning needs within a heterogeneous environment if in a magnet or non-magnet classroom.
If we opt for OneGp Virtual, is the magnet program going to differ in resources or programming compared to a non magnet experience?	If enrollment warrants a section of Magnet in OneGP Virtual, that section will run in the same manner that a Magnet classroom would run in the traditional school environment, but virtually. The magnet program in the traditional school environment utilized GPPSS curriculum and resources similarly to typical GP 3rd and 4th grade classrooms.
If we elect another learning option outside of GPPSS this year can s/he resume the magnet program next year or must s/he reapply/test into the program?	If a student is magnet eligible then that eligibility will continue to be in place for the following year. With that said, there are no guarantees of a magnet slot when a student returns. If there isn't room then the student would be placed on a

	waitlist.
If we elect to begin the year online and feel our child has fallen too far behind due to our limited availability to assist him due to working or family situations can we pull him from the program this year and re-enroll the following year?	If a student is magnet eligible then that eligibility will continue to be in place for the following year. With that said, consulting with the building principal and teacher prior to enrolling into magnet will be encouraged. Also, there will be no guarantee of a magnet slot when a student returns. If there isn't room then the student would be placed on a waitlist.
If we do OneGp Virtual my son is going into 4th grade (3rd year in magnet) since he has already completed 4th grade math I don't feel a regular 4th grade class experience would meet his needs. What can we expect to meet his needs?	Math curriculum will be provided based on students' readiness level. We do know that students that require a 'level up' for math can be fully accommodated in OneGP Virtual.
Can you confirm there will be a magnet classroom at Defer if we opt for the remote and eventually face to face option? Can you confirm classrooms at the other locations throughout the district?	Magnet classrooms will be subject to OneGP Virtual enrollment. If OneGP Virtual enrollment substantially decreases the number of students in our GP Traditional Magnet classes at Defer, Monteith, Richard, and Ferry then the district will combine and adjust classrooms accordingly.
If we elect to do OneGP Virtual and end up with a non-magnet teacher/section, will we be guaranteed a spot in the magnet program when we return face to face, either in January if we make the switch or next year?	Only for next year based on enrollment. No guarantee of a slot for the second semester. If there is room we would grant it.
My child missed out on their 5th grade magnet experience due to reconfiguration and 5th grade moving to the middle school. Can OneGP Virtual create a 5th grade magnet class?	5th grade magnet is no longer an option in our school district due to reconfiguration. 5th grade students who enroll in OneGP Virtual will be placed in a traditional 5th grade classroom and differentiation will occur accordingly.

Multi Age FAQ

Will the Multi Age program continue with the current teacher in One GP Virtual or will that teacher stay in OneGP traditional?	Staffing decisions regarding OneGP Virtual have not been made (they will be made after we have enrollment data). With regards to the current teacher, like all staff, teachers will have the opportunity to pursue a OneGP Virtual teaching slot.
Will there be a OneGP traditional Multi Age and a OneGP Virtual Multi Age?	Only one Multi Age will run (either OneGP Traditional or Virtual) based on enrollment. If we do not have enough students to enroll in OneGP Virtual with an interest in Multi Age, then OneGP Virtual will not offer Multi Age. There is no way at the Elementary School level to have a teacher teach simultaneously in both OneGP Virtual and traditional.
