### Listening sessions – the 'why'

- Introduction as new superintendent
- Addressed need for healing inside the district due to pandemic, reconfiguration, etc.
- Created an opportunity for people to feel heard
- Open to anyone in the community who wanted to attend



### Listening sessions

- Held between May 27 and June 23, 2021
- Took place at all buildings, including Barnes and 389 St. Clair
- Approximately 120 community members (parents, grandparents, staff) in attendance
  – from two to 35 people at each
- One or more (no more than three) board members in attendance at each
