 - Teacher Recommendation
 - Placement test 60% or higher

- 5th and 6th grade composite GP Writing score of 11 or higher
 - NWEA score of 228 or higher
 - Teacher Recommendation

AVID

(Advancement Via Individual Determination)

- AVID is a program for students who demonstrate that they are capable of completing a rigorous curriculum of Honors level courses but are currently falling short of their potential.
- AVID is an elective class that is focused on writing, inquiry, collaboration, organization and reading to help students strengthen skills that are needed in high school and college. It is a one hour daily elective.
- AVID requires an application process by any interested 6 -8th grade student. This application is available in the spring of 2021.
