All current 7th graders will be completing registration for their 8th grade school in early 2022. Please review and complete the 8th grade Course Selection sheet attached below. All eighth grade students will be automatically scheduled to take math, science, English and social studies as mandatory courses based on current classes. All honors placements will be reviewed in June 2022 for final placement. <u>Parcells Honors Criteria Link</u>

Your child will only need to select elective classes. <u>Elective classes MUST total 2 full year</u> <u>classes, 4 semester classes or a combination of 1 full year and 2 semester classes (Please note</u> <u>that semester classes are only half a year.)</u> Click on the <u>Middle School Program of Studies</u> and review course descriptions. 8th grade students are allowed to select foreign languages (German 1 only) at North HS as long as the family provides all transportation between schools and scheduling aligns with North.

As you review the elective class registration form with your child, please guide them as they make their choices and <u>sign the form</u>. *We will make every effort to honor your choices; however, please be aware that students may receive some, but not necessarily all, of their elective course choices.*

Your child must return the registration form to their <u>Science teacher</u> no later than Friday, March 4th, 2022.
