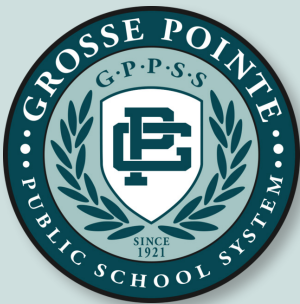

Maintaining traditions and operating stately facilities can be quite costly. The upkeep of these historic sites often involves significant financial investment due to the need for regular maintenance, updates to comply with modern standards, and the inherent inefficiencies compared to newer, more advanced facilities.

2024 Operating Millage Renewal Overview

The proposed 2024 Operating Millage supports GPPSS's efforts to maintain its current operation without interruptions. It also maintains and improves educational programs, staffing, and resources. This millage would raise approximately \$22,400,000 in the first year of levy, while not increasing the millage rate for homeowners. Without this millage, the district will lose this vital funding and the programs and activities it supports.

Will this increase the property tax rate on my home?

ZERO TAX RATE INCREASE

No. For GPPSS homeowners, this millage restoration will extend the current authority for homeowners and will not increase tax rates over the current authorization.
