AGENDA TITLE: Field Trip for Grosse Pointe South:

Trip to Stratford, ON, Canada

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Learning Objectives:

AP Lit students have intensively studied this play in written form, viewing the classic version starring Sir Lawrence Olivier, as well as excerpts from other iterations. Seeing it--as originally intended--in a live production would give them yet another opportunity to deepen and broaden their understanding of the work.

Acting students will have the opportunity to watch professional actors immersed in their craft, interpreting the dialogue and directions of The Bard of Avon on a traditional Shakespearean stage.
