Confidentiality:

Confidentiality means that the privacy of information that you share with your counselor belongs to you. You may share information with others as you wish, but we understand that you have a right to privacy as much as is permitted by the law, ethics, and school rules.

There are times that parents request information be shared with others, at which time a release form must be signed. You should know that there are exceptions where we are obligated to break confidentiality. These include times where there is potential risk of harm to or by an individual; state laws that mandate reporting of child abuse, or a court of law that requires testimony or student records.

Counselors occasionally consult with other school professionals, but only share information necessary to achieving the goals of the consult.
