



7th GRADE MATH CLASS INFORMATION SHEET MRS. KRIER

MATERIALS NEEDED DAILY: Students are to bring a calculator, a folder with pockets, assignment book, a pencil and a red pen to class each day.

HOMEWORK: Homework will be given every day, except quiz/test days. Students will have time at the end of class to start their homework. Work and steps must be shown unless otherwise stated by the teacher. Homework will be checked by the student and collected by the teacher immediately after checking it. Each assignment is worth up to 5 pts. A zero will be assigned if work is not shown; also, points will be taken off if an assignment is incomplete. Pencils should be used when completing homework assignments.

Absent students are responsible for

- ✓ Getting the notes given on the date of absence
- ✓ Getting assignment given on the date of absence
- ✓ Turning in the work that was due the date of the absence

TAKING NOTES: Students are encouraged to take notes in class. Students are encouraged to write neatly and write examples down that are given in class. The daily notes will be posted on my website by the end of the school day. Look at the Math 7 Calendar.

ASSIGNMENT BOOK: Students are to bring their assignment book to class each day. Students should write down the assignment as soon as it is given and they should write in upcoming quizzes, tests, projects, etc. in their assignment books. They must use their assignment book for hall passes and to leave the classroom.

QUIZZES: There will be at least one quiz given before every chapter test – usually, there will be two. Students may use their notes on every quiz. The notes must be taken in the students' handwriting. Printed copies from my website will **NOT** be permitted. Quizzes must be finished by the end of the hour – no extra time will be given. If a student is absent on a quiz day, the student should attend 7th hour the next day to make up the quiz.

TESTS: Tests will be given at the end of each chapter, usually every 3-4 weeks. Notes may **not** be used on tests. Tests must be finished by the end of the hour, unless otherwise stated by the teacher. Tests may not be retaken. . If a student is absent on a test day, the student should attend 7th hour the next day to make up the test.

PARTICIPATION: Students are expected to participate in class. Participation involves asking questions, answering questions, helping out with activities, working in a group, and going to the chalkboard. The more a student participates, the more he or she will learn in class and have fun!

TEXTBOOK: The textbook is available as a CD. If the CD is lost or damaged, the replacement cost is \$70. The book is also available online. The website is <http://my.hrw.com>; the username is **parcells1** and the password is **u8e7v**.

BEHAVIOR: Students are expected to follow the Student Code of Conduct and behavior matrix (see assignment book). Progressive steps will be taken if a student misbehaves in class.
