Students in Figurative Arts will be able to draw the full figure, hands, and head using a variety of methods and materials. Students work directly from models who are often members of the class. Students are encouraged to learn realism and accuracy, but also to creatively interpret the figure to develop their own personal style, whether that be fashion figures, cartooning, animation, illustration, or even 3D clay sculpting. Students also learn how different artists have drawn the figure throughout various periods in art history. Students enrolled in Figurative Arts II, III, and IV have the opportunity to do advanced work in a wider variety of media and style. Students will perform, present, respond, connect, create, analyze, and analyze in context adhering to current state and national standards. Essential materials for this course will be provided.
