AGENDA TITLE: Approval of Staff Laptop Devices for Additional Buildings

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

With the passing of the 2018 Bond, the Technology Department will be updating devices across the district. A big focus in Technology is mobility, and the transition from classroom desktops to classroom laptops for teaching devices will be a welcome change.

The District's original plan was to upgrade devices following Bond Construction; however, with the onset of Covid-19 and Remote Learning, we felt it important to be able to provide all of our instructional staff with appropriate devices to be able to work from any location.

The District is requesting device upgrades for the following buildings: Richard, Brownell, Pierce, Mason, Kerby, Maire, and Barnes as well as laptop purchases for office staff for all of the GPPSS buildings.

The purchase of this equipment includes the following:

- Laptops for staff
- Docking Stations, Mice, and Monitors for Administrators, Office Staff, Counselors, Librarians, and other Behavioral Support staff
- Carrying Cases for Devices

The purchase of this equipment is currently going through a Cooperative Bid by Dell. We are currently working on a final price, and will have this amount presented to you prior to the August 24th Board Meeting. Based on previous pricing, we believe the cost of the equipment should come around to \$623,547.46 for 420 Laptops, and 184 Monitor Bundles. We are also asking for a 10% contingency of \$62,354.75

Request: Board approval of Bond Device Purchases for an estimated cost of \$623,547.46 for 420 laptops, and 184 monitor bundles with a 10% contingency of \$62,354.75.
