




Retirement Rate




GPPSS Enrollment




State & GPPSS Enrollment




GF Revenue by Source




General Fund Revenue 2022-2023 GAAA #1




Pandemic Relief Funding




GF Expenditures by Object



General Fund Expenditures 2022-2023 GAAA #1




General Fund – Fund Balance






