

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION BEING GATHERED

The following is being gathered for the 2016-17 school year and will be presented to the Board of Education in August, 2017:

- Actual participation per sport
- Actual costs per sport including employment costs such as salaries, MPSERS, FICA and contracting fees
- Transportation costs per sport
- An analysis of any significant differences between North and South in terms of the above
- The role custodial accounts play in transferring funds between parents and other fundraising



IMPORTANT LIMITATIONS/NOTES

Athletics is one area in the school district where there is significant overlap between items that are sponsored (meaning paid) by the District and items that are sponsored via booster/parent groups. Please note the following:

- Booster groups are separate 501(c)3 organizations that the district does not control
- The funds parents pay to our booster organizations are not monitored by school district personnel and cannot be accurately reported out to the Board of Education from the district

ADDITIONALLY REQUESTED ITEMS

Administration intends to provide the Board of Education and the community the necessary information to build trust and increase transparency.
