*In order to make the first days back run a little smoother for everyone we are asking that **BEFORE** your first day of classes you take a few minutes to access your semester 2 schedule in MiStar. Here are the steps to take to locate your information:*

Log into the Parent Portal or Student Portal and go to "Schedule." This will show you all relevant info: period, term (e.g. YS, S1, S2), course code, class name, teacher, room number, and entry and exit dates. Term YS are year-long classes. Print out your schedule or take a picture of it, whatever will be easier for you to refer to on your first day back to F2F.

Good afternoon South traditional and OGPV students and families!

As we work to finalize plans for the return to the building with the hybrid schedule, we will continue to share information as often as possible.

2nd semester Schedules: both traditional and OGPV

At this time, you may check your second semester schedule by logging into the MiStar Student Portal. There have been changes to the schedule, including period changes and teacher changes. There have been many course changes between traditional (Hybrid Face to Face) and OneGP Virtual and we tried to build the schedule to fit as many course requests as possible. Please connect with your counselor if you have any questions.

Semester 1 Book Drop-off & Semester 2 Book Pick-up: both Traditional and OGPV

We will be collecting 1st semester books and handing out books for second semester classes. We have set aside 3 days for you to drop books back off at South and pick up second semester books. The books that you should be returning are for your semester classes like Government, Sociology, Mythology, etc. The other books that can be returned are English novels that your classes already read. Please check in with your teacher if you aren't sure if a book can be returned. Year long classes use textbooks for the entire year and should NOT be turned in. See below for all of the options to drop-off books:

Thursday, Jan 21	<p>The school will be open from 12-3 for you to drop off/pick up books in the library. Enter the library through door J.</p> <p>Seniors may also pick up their hybrid parking permit.</p>
Friday, Jan 22	<p>This is records day and students do not have classes. The school will be open from 10-3 for you to drop off/pick up books in the library. Enter the library through door J.</p> <p>Seniors may also pick up their hybrid parking permit.</p>
Monday, Jan 25	<p>Freshmen orientation. No book exchange scheduled.</p>
Tuesday, Jan, 26	<p>This is the day set aside for junior PSAT/NMSQT testing. Students do not have class. The building will be open from 12-3 for you to drop off/pick up your books in ROOM 166. Enter the building through door L.</p>
Wednesday, Jan 27	<p>Remote Learning Schedule. No book exchange scheduled.</p>

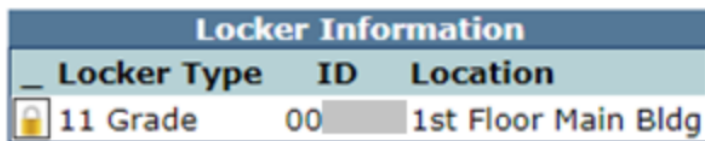
Thursday, Jan 28 Friday, Jan 29	Thursday is the first day of face to face hybrid schedule. Books can be exchanged during lunch time in ROOM 166 .
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Please make every effort to get books exchanged on the available dates listed above.

Lockers: Traditional students only

When we begin the hybrid schedule, students will only be able to access lockers when you arrive at school and then at the end of the day when students get ready to leave school. To find out your locker ID, location and locker combination, follow the directions below:

1. Go to your MiStar Student Portal
2. Click on the new "Enrollment" area in the portal (which unfortunately also has a lot of other enrollment information besides the locker info) and scroll down until you see this:



3. The locker ID # is displayed here, and by clicking on the gold lock icon on the left, you will get a pop-up window that shows both your locker ID and the combination. This extra step is required as a safety measure so that the combination only displays when it's safe for you to look at it.

Enter the building through the J entrance following safe social distancing protocols.

Students must present proof of insurance, registration, and a valid driver's license in order to receive their decal.

**Additional Hybrid Only Decals Available**

A limited number of S-Lot parking spaces are still available. Those Seniors with incomplete parking applications, will have priority assignment of Hybrid Parking decals if they submit the required information by the deadline. Juniors and Seniors who wish to apply for a Hybrid Only Space must submit a complete application for entry into a lottery for the remaining spaces by Wed. January 20, 2021.

Click on the 3 links above to access the forms. The agreement must be printed and signed. Lottery winners will be notified to pick up their Decals in the main office, Wednesday January 27th after 12:00 PM

Hybrid Parking Decals are only valid while GP South is in the Hybrid Face to Face schedule. Each Cohort will have a different parking decal. Cohort A will be issued a gold permit for AM use, and Cohort B will be issued a blue permit for PM use. Upon return to full time face to face instruction Senior students with parking applications completed in the Fall of 2020 will receive a new decal for full day use of their assigned spot.
