Create a collage poster using the guidelines below. Collages will be presented in class beginning October 11. **Turn in this rubric with your collage.**

**\*\*Extra Credit opportunity: Present an "A" project by October 4, and earn 10 bonus points for each grade.**

### Project

\_\_\_\_\_ Begin with ½ poster and cut it into a shape that represents something important in the novel. (10 pts)

\_\_\_\_\_ Cover all the space with pictures relating to the novel's main character(s), plot (beginning, middle and end,) setting (where and when) and theme (lesson we can all learn.) (40 pts)

\_\_\_\_\_ Be consistent with media (all magazines, all computer-generated, etc.) (10 pts)

\_\_\_\_\_ Include your name, novel title and author on an index card attached to the **front** of the collage. (10 pts)

\_\_\_\_\_ Be neat. (15 pts)

\_\_\_\_\_ Be creative. (15 pts)

### Presentation

\_\_\_\_\_ Use 2-3 pictures to identify the main character(s) and something interesting about each (10pts)

\_\_\_\_\_ Use 1-2 pictures to describe the setting, where and when the novel takes place (5 pts)

\_\_\_\_\_ Use 4-5 pictures to show the complications in the plot (15 pts)

\_\_\_\_\_ Use 1 picture to explain the theme or lesson of the story (10 pts)

\_\_\_\_\_ Speak loudly enough so the back of the room can hear you. (20 pts)

\_\_\_\_\_ Speak slowly and clearly so we can understand you. (20 pts)

\_\_\_\_\_ Speak fluently. Practice a few times before you share it with the class, so you know ahead of time which pictures you'll share and what you'd like to say about them. (20 pts)
