Protista	EUKARYOTE	HETEROTROPH (SOME AUTO-)	UNICELLULAR	Majority innocuous, some disease-causing	<b>MUST FIND ON YOUR OWN!!</b>
Plantae	EUKARYOTE	AUTOTROPH	MULTICELLULAR	Mainly stay in one place	<b>MUST FIND ON YOUR OWN!!</b>
Fungi	EUKARYOTE	HETEROTROPH	MULTICELLULAR	Many feed on dead or decaying organisms	<b>MUST FIND ON YOUR OWN!!</b>
Animalia	EUKARYOTE	HETEROTROPH	MULTICELLULAR	Diverse	<b>MUST FIND ON YOUR OWN!!</b>
